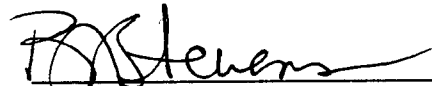
Ms. Stevens waives any further findings with respect to this matter. The surrende registration is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force bein against her.

Ms. Stevens understands and accepts that, at any point in the future, she may peti reinstatement by submitting a request to the Board of Pharmacy, in writing. Upon a req reinstatement, the Board will determine within sixty (60) days when it will schedule a hea

The decision will be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at a formal hearing before the Board. The registration will not be returned until and unless the Board issues a reinstatement order after any formal hearing.
