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VOLUNTARY SURRENDER  
OF LICENSE FOR CAUSE

Joseph Wayne Wallace was issued license number 11472 by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on July 24, 1991, such license being active until December 31, 2007.

Mr. Wallace admits that while being licensed as a pharmacist in North Carolina, he committed acts that give the Board sufficient cause to revoke his license to practice pharmacy. Considering that, Mr. Wallace voluntarily surrenders his license to practice pharmacy in North Carolina. The surrender of the license is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against him. As a result of the voluntary surrender, Mr. Wallace shall not be present in any pharmacy except as a customer.


Mr. Wallace understands and accepts that, at any point in the future, he may petition for reinstatement by submitting a request to the Board of Pharmacy, in writing. Upon a request for reinstatement, the Board will schedule a hearing at its convenience, which may or may not occur at the next regularly scheduled Board meeting following the request. There is no presumption, guarantee or other implication intended within this document that the Board will reinstate the license. The decision will be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at a formal hearing before the Board. The license will not be returned until and unless the Board issues a reinstatement order after any formal hearing.
