AMENDMENT TO THE
FINAL DECISION

THIS MATTER came on for hearing before the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy ("Board") on March 18, 2003. Based upon the record in this proceeding and the testimony and exhibits presented at the hearing, the Board set forth Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and its Order in the Final Decision issued on May 13, 2003.

As the Board no longer offers a jurisprudence exam which was required of Respondent Pace in the Final Decision, the Board hereby amends the Final Decision as follows:

Paragraph 1(b) under "Ordered" is hereby stricken and replaced as follows:


Within thirty (30) days of receipt of this Amended Final Decision, Respondent Pace shall mail an application for the Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Exam to the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy and shall provide the Board with a written copy of the application. Additionally, Respondent Pace shall take and pass the Exam within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy that he is "authorized to test" for the Exam;

All of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and all other Orders of the Board in the Final Decision issued on May 13, 2003 shall remain in full force and effect, effective on the date on which the Final Decision was issued by the Board.
