SUSPENSION OF LICENSE

Pursuant to G.S. §150B-3(c) and 21 N.C.A.C. 46.2006(b), the North Carolina Board of

Pharmacy (Board) finds that the protection of the public health, safety and welfare requires

emergency action and hereby summarily suspends License No. 6804 issued to Celeste Michele

Lindley (Respondent), effective upon service of this Order. Respondent shall immediately cease the

practice of pharmacy in North Carolina pending issuance by the Board of a Final Agency Decision.

This summary suspension shall be stayed, however, if Respondent, within forty-eight hours of the

service of this Order, meets with Paul D. Peterson, Executive Director of the North Carolina

Pharmacist Recovery Network (NCPRN), and thereafter follows and complies with the

recommendations and instructions of NCPRN.

Should Respondent's license be summarily suspended, a hearing before the Board regarding

the charges against Respondent shall be conducted on January 18, 2005 at 10:00 a.m. at the Board's

office located at 6015 Farrington Road, Suite 201, Chapel Hill, North Carolina. Respondent will be

served with a Notice of Hearing in accordance with G.S. §150B-38(b) containing the allegations to

be heard.
