OF LICENSE


Amy Dianne Boyce was issued license number 09363 by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on July 29, 1986.

Ms. Boyce admits that while working as a licensed pharmacist with Wal-Mart pharmacy, located at 2628 S. Main Street, High Point, North Carolina, she committed acts that gave the Board sufficient cause to revoke her license to practice pharmacy in North Carolina.

Considering that, Ms. Boyce voluntarily surrenders her license to practice pharmacy in North Carolina. The surrender of the license is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against her. As a result of the voluntary surrender, Ms. Boyce shall not be present in any pharmacy except as a customer.


Ms. Boyce understands and accepts that, at any point in the future, she may petition for reinstatement by submitting a request to the Board of Pharmacy, in writing. Upon a request for reinstatement, the Board will determine within 60 days when it will schedule a hearing on the request for reinstatement. There is no presumption, guarantee or other implication intended within this document that the Board will reinstate the license. The decision will be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at a formal hearing before the Board. The license will not be returned until and unless the Board issues a reinstatement order after any formal hearing.
