THIS MATTER came on for hearing upon request of Genny Marie Brewer (“Petitioner”) for modification of a July 19, 2011 Board order. Petitioner requested that the Board lift a restriction on her license contained in that order prohibiting her from acting as a preceptor of pharmacy students. Petitioner’s request was heard on February 19, 2013 by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) located at 6015 Farrington Rd., Suite 201, Chapel Hill, North Carolina, by Board members Minton, Marks, McLaughlin, Chesson, Day, and Mixon. After receiving evidence, hearing testimony, and adjudging the credibility of the witnesses, the Board makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Petitioner provided evidence of her compliance with all terms of the July 19, 2011 Order.
2. Cindy Clark, interim executive director of the North Carolina Pharmacist Recovery Network (“NCPRN”) stated that Petitioner has maintained compliance with her treatment and monitoring obligations.
3. NCPRN supports Petitioner’s request for modification of the July 19, 2011 Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Petitioner has demonstrated that she continues to maintain successful recovery and compliance with her PRN contract and the July 19, 2011 Order. The Board, in its discretion, concludes that a modification of the July 19, 2011 Order is appropriate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Petitioner's request is **GRANTED**.

Paragraph 5 of the July 19, 2011 Order stating "Petitioner shall not serve as a preceptor of pharmacy students" is hereby lifted.


