THIS MATTER was heard on September 16, 2008, by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) located at 6015 Farrington Road, Suite 201, Chapel Hill, North Carolina, upon the request of Hailey Barbee Brady (“Petitioner”) for modification of the Board’s January 17, 2006 order reinstating her license to practice pharmacy in the state of North Carolina with conditions. Board members Haywood, Nelson, Chesson, Chater, and Dennis conducted this hearing. After hearing the testimony of witnesses, adjudging the credibility of the witnesses, and receiving evidence, the Board makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On January 17, 2006 the Board entered an order reinstating Petitioner’s license to practice pharmacy number 08729 with conditions (“2006 Order”).
2. Paragraph 5 of the 2006 Order states “Petitioner shall not serve as pharmacist manager of any pharmacy.”
3. Petitioner has complied with all conditions of the 2006 Order.
4. Paul Peterson, Executive Director of the North Carolina Pharmacist Recovery Network, testified that Petitioner is in full compliance with her PRN obligations and that PRN supports Petitioner’s modification request.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board, in its discretion, concludes that Petitioner may safely act as a pharmacist-manager.


