

**BEFORE THE NORTH CAROLINA BOARD OF PHARMACY**

THIS MATTER came to be considered the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) on November 18, 2014 upon the request of Amanda Gatlin (“Petitioner”) to modify the terms of a January 19, 2010 Board order reinstating her North Carolina license to practice pharmacy with conditions. Board members McLaughlin, Chesson, Minton, Day, and Mixon heard this matter. After hearing the testimony of witnesses, adjudging the credibility of the witnesses, and receiving evidence, the Board makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On January 19, 2010, the Board issued an Order Reinstating License With Conditions to Petitioner (the “2010 Order”), who holds North Carolina license to practice pharmacy number 11866.
2. Petitioner asks the Board to lift Condition 3 of the 2010 Order: “Petitioner shall obtain prior approval of all employment as a pharmacist from the Board’s Executive Director.”
3. Petitioner asks the Board to lift Condition 4 of the 2010 Order: “Petitioner shall not serve as a pharmacist manager of any pharmacy.”
4. Petitioner asks the Board to lift Condition 5 of the 2010 Order: ““Petitioner shall not serve as a preceptor of pharmacy students.”

5. Since the Board reinstated Petitioner's license, Petitioner has been employed as a pharmacist for almost five years. The Board has received no complaint concerning Petitioner's practice during that time.
6. North Carolina Pharmacist Recovery Network ("NCPRN") supports these modifications of Petitioner's 2010 Order.
7. Petitioner remains under a treatment and monitoring agreement with NCPRN through January 2015.
8. NCPRN reports that Petitioner has been in substantial compliance with her NCPRN treatment and monitoring obligations since the 2010 Order.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Petitioner has demonstrated that, with modifications to the 2010 Order, she will continue to practice pharmacy with appropriate care, safety and competence

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Petitioner's 2010 Order is amended as follows:  
Conditions 3, 4, and 5 are lifted.
