THIS MATTER came to be considered the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) on January 20, 2015 upon the request of Ronald Hatter (“Petitioner”) to modify the terms of a September 24, 2002 Board order reinstating his North Carolina license to practice pharmacy with conditions. Board members McLaughlin, Chesson, Day, and Mixon heard this matter. After hearing the testimony of witnesses, adjudging the credibility of the witnesses, and receiving evidence, the Board makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 24, 2002, the Board issued an Order Reinstating License With Conditions to Petitioner (the “2002 Order”), who holds North Carolina license to practice pharmacy number 15305.
2. Petitioner asks the Board to modify lift Condition 3 of the 2002 Order: “Petitioner shall not serve as a pharmacist manager of any pharmacy.”
3. Since the Board reinstated Petitioner’s license, the Board has received no complaint concerning Petitioner’s practice.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Petitioner has demonstrated that, with modifications to the 2002 Order, he will continue to practice pharmacy with appropriate care, safety and competence

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Petitioner's 2010 Order is amended as follows:

Conditions 3 is amended to state: "Petitioner shall not serve as pharmacist manager of any pharmacy that holds a Drug Enforcement Administration registration."
