

**BEFORE THE NORTH CAROLINA BOARD OF PHARMACY**

**THIS MATTER** was heard on September 18, 2012, by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) located at 6015 Farrington Road, Suite 201, Chapel Hill, North Carolina, upon the request of Kelly House Long (“Petitioner”) to modify the terms of an October 16, 2007 Board order reinstating her North Carolina license to practice pharmacy number 13493. Board members Minton, Marks, Chesson, Day, and Mixon heard this matter. After hearing the testimony of witnesses, adjudging the credibility of the witnesses, and receiving evidence, the Board makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On October 16, 2007, the Board issued an Order Reinstating License With Conditions to Petitioner (the “2007 Order”), who holds North Carolina pharmacist license number 13493.
2. Petitioner asks the Board to lift Conditions 3 (prior approval of employment by the Board’s Executive Director), 4 (prohibiting service as a pharmacist manager), 7 (prohibiting practice of pharmacy for more than 40 hours per week on average) and 9 (requiring certain disclosures) of the 2007 Order
3. The Board received testimony from North Carolina Pharmacist Recovery Network (“NCPRN”) supporting Petitioner’s requested modifications.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Petitioner has demonstrated that, with modifications to the 2007 Order, she will continue to practice pharmacy with reasonable care, safety and competence

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Petitioner's 2007 Order is amended to lift conditions 3, 4, 7 and 9. Other conditions of the 2007 Order remain in effect.


