Rosa M. Mahiquez holds license number 11133 issued by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy to practice pharmacy.

Ms. Mahiquez admits that she has failed to comply with her North Carolina Pharmacist Recovery Network (NCPRN) contract. Accordingly, Ms. Mahiquez voluntarily surrenders her license to practice pharmacy in North Carolina.

Ms. Mahiquez understands and accepts that the license will not be returned until and unless NCPRN is willing to advocate for her, and the Board issues a Reinstatement Order. It is Ms. Mahiquez's responsibility to petition the Board for a Hearing if she wishes to have the matter considered.

Ms. Mahiquez shall not be present in a pharmacy except as a customer unless her license is returned by the Board. This document contains no presumption, guarantee, or other implication that the Board will reinstate the license. There is no time limit established for this matter to be heard by the Board. The decision will be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at a formal hearing before the Board.

The surrender of the license is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against her.


