Frederick A. Mays was issued Pharmacist License number 10,812 by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on May 5, 1990.


Frederick A. Mays admits that while employed at CVS Pharmacy located at 3440 Wilkinson Blvd. Charlotte, NC he committed acts that give the Board sufficient cause to revoke his license. Considering that, Mr. Mays voluntarily surrenders his license as a Pharmacist in North Carolina.

Mr. Mays understands and accepts that the surrender of his Pharmacist license will be considered as a revocation-for-cause of the registration.


Mr. Mays waives any further findings with respect to this matter. The surrender of the license is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against him.

Mr. Mays understands and accepts that he is not to work as a pharmacist in North Carolina unless the license is reinstated by the Board following a formal hearing. It is Mr. Mays responsibility to petition the Board for a hearing if he wishes to have the matter considered. Further, there is no presumption; guarantee or other implication intended within this document that the Board will reinstate the registration. The decision would be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at the time of the formal hearing.
