THIS MATTER came on for consideration at a prehearing conference (hereinafter, "conference") pursuant to 21 N.C.A.C. 46 .2008. This conference was scheduled for May 14, 2010 and, after appropriate notice, was heard on that day at the office of the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy (hereinafter, "Board") by Board member Dr. J. Parker Chesson, Jr. Board Counsel and members of the Board's investigative and legal staff were present at this conference. Mr. McGrath was informed of his right to be present at the conference, in person, and waived that right.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On March 19, 1996, Respondent Paul C. McGrath was granted license number 13352 by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy by reciprocity from the State of Maine.
2. Since his licensure in the State of North Carolina, Respondent has continued to practice pharmacy in Maine.
3. On or about January 5, 2012, Respondent entered into a Consent Agreement with the Maine Board of Pharmacy following an investigation by the Maine Board of Pharmacy into activities that Respondent undertook while practicing in Maine.
4. The findings of fact and covenants in the Consent Agreement are incorporated herein by reference, and Respondent admits and agrees to those findings of fact and covenants.

5. The Consent Agreement provided for a warning to be issued to Respondent. In addition, it provided for a civil penalty and additional continuing education requirements, which the Maine Board of Pharmacy has represented have already been satisfied.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


Based on the above findings, the Board concludes as a matter of law:

1. Respondent Paul C. McGrath, Jr. violated N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-85.38(a)(6).
2. Respondent admits that the conduct in this matter constitutes sufficient grounds for disciplinary action on his license under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-85.38.

Based upon the foregoing, and with the consent of the parties, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the license of Respondent Paul C. McGrath, Jr. is hereby REPRIMANDED.
