THIS MATTER was heard on July 15, 2014, by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) located at 6015 Farrington Road, Suite 201, Chapel Hill, North Carolina, upon the request of David Brian Mozingo (“Petitioner”) for the Board to modify a Consent Order. Board members McLaughlin, Marks, Minton, Chesson, Day, and Mixon conducted the hearing. After hearing the testimony of witnesses, adjudging the credibility of the witnesses, and receiving evidence, the Board makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 20, 2011, the Board entered into a Consent Order of discipline with Petitioner (the “2011 Order”), who holds North Carolina pharmacist license number 21356.
2. The 2011 Order placed certain conditions on Petitioner’s license to practice pharmacy.
3. Petitioner asks the Board to lift the following condition of the 2011 Order:
“[Petitioner] shall not serve as a pharmacist-manager of any pharmacy.”
4. North Carolina Pharmacist Recovery Network supports this modification of Petitioner’s 2011 Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Petitioner has demonstrated that, with modifications to the 2011 Order, he will continue to practice pharmacy with reasonable care, safety and competence.




