THIS MATTER was heard on September 20, 2011, by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) located at 6015 Farrington Road, Suite 201, Chapel Hill, North Carolina, upon the request of James Mundy (“Petitioner”) for the Board to modify an Order Reinstating License. Board members Dennis, Minton, Chater, Chesson, and Marks conducted the hearing. After hearing the testimony of witnesses, adjudging the credibility of the witnesses, and receiving evidence, the Board makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 17, 2007, the Board issued an Order Reinstating License to Petitioner (the “2007 Order”), who holds North Carolina pharmacist license number 11403.
2. The 2007 Order reinstated Petitioner’s license to practice pharmacy with conditions.
3. Petitioner asks the Board to lift or modify the following conditions of the 2007 Order:
 2. * * *
 - c. Petitioner shall obtain prior approval of all employment as a pharmacist from the Board’s Executive Director.

d. Petitioner shall not serve as a pharmacist manager of any pharmacy without prior approval from the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy's Executive Director.

e. Petitioner shall not serve as a preceptor of pharmacy students.

f. Petitioner may not be employed as a pharmacist more than 40 hours per week, on the average.

4. NCPRN supports this modification of Petitioner's 2007 Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Petitioner has demonstrated that, with modifications to the 2007 Order, he will continue to practice pharmacy with reasonable care, safety and competence


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Petitioner's 2007 Order is amended to lift conditions 2(d), 2(e), and 2(f).

Condition 2(c) is modified as follows: Petitioner shall obtain prior approval of all employment as a pharmacist from North Carolina Pharmacist Recovery Network for the duration of his NCPRN contract.

Other conditions of the 2007 Order remain in effect.
