Michelle Marie O'Mery was issued license number 15669 by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on August 17, 2000, such license being active until December 31, 2008.


Ms. O'Mery admits that while working as a licensed pharmacist with Walgreens Pharmacy located on 941 Durham Road, Wake Forest, North Carolina, she committed acts that give the Board sufficient cause to revoke her license to practice pharmacy in North Carolina.

Considering that, Ms. O'Mery voluntarily surrenders her license to practice pharmacy in North Carolina. The surrender of the license is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against her. As a result of the voluntary surrender, Ms. O'Mery shall not be present in any pharmacy in any capacity other than as a customer/patient, with a valid prescription from a treating physician, unless and until the Board issues any further order.

Ms. O'Mery understands and accepts that, at any point in the future, she may petition for reinstatement by submitting a request to the Board of Pharmacy, in writing. Upon a request for reinstatement, the Board will determine within sixty (60) days when it will schedule a hearing on the request for reinstatement. That hearing will be scheduled at the Board's discretion. There is no presumption, guarantee or other implication intended within this document that the Board will reinstate the license.

The decision will be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at a formal hearing before the Board. The license will not be returned until and unless the Board issues a reinstatement order after any formal hearing.
