(License No. 13048)) SUSPENDING LICENSE

Pursuant to G.S. § 150B-3(c) and 21 N.C.A.C. 46.2006(b), the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy ("Board"), vis Members Rebecca W. Chater, J. Parker Chesson, Jr., Betty H. Dennis, Robert (Joey) McLaughlin, Jr., E. Lazelle Marks and Gene Minton find that the protection of the public health, safety and welfare requires emergency action. Accordingly, the Board hereby Summarily Suspends License No. 13048 issued to Heather Hindsley Tetterton ("Respondent Tetterton"), effective upon service of this Order. Respondent Tetterton shall immediately cease any practice of pharmacy in North Carolina pending issuance by the Board of a Final Agency Decision.

You may request a hearing on the charges against you by submitting a written request within 60 days of service of this order, pursuant to 21 N.C.A.C. 46. 2004. Within 60 days of receipt of your written request, the Board will issue a notice of hearing with respect to whether the summary suspension should be continued. That notice will advise you of the date and time of the hearing, which will be set within the discretion of the Board. In the event that you request a hearing, this summary suspension remains in effect until the issuance of a further decision by the Board.

If you do not request a hearing as set forth above, you waive the right to contest the Board's decision and the suspension imposed upon you by this order. However, you retain the right to file a written petition for reinstatement of your license at any time following this order.

The Board will set a hearing at a time and place within its discretion and will rule on the petition for reinstatement in its discretion under its duty to consider the public health, safety and welfare.


