CONSENT ORDER

THIS MATTER came on for consideration at a prehearing conference (hereinafter, "conference") pursuant to 21 N.C.A.C. 46 .2008. This conference was scheduled for September 20, 2010 and, after appropriate notice, was heard on that day at the office of the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy (hereinafter, "Board") by Board member Gene Minton. Board Counsel and members of the Board's investigative and legal staff were present at this conference. Ms. Wiltshire was informed of her right to be present at the conference, in person, and waived that right.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On November 19, 2008, Respondent Monika Annette Wiltshire was granted license number 20133 by reciprocity from the State of New York.
2. On June 22, 2010, Respondent's New York license was disciplined through a Consent Order following an investigation by the New York Board of Pharmacy into activities that Respondent undertook while practicing in New York.
3. The Specification of Professional Misconduct in the New York Consent Order is incorporated herein by reference, and Respondent does not contest the Specification of Professional Misconduct.
4. The New York Consent Order provided for a one-year suspension of Respondent's New York license, stayed for one year, upon certain conditions.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the above findings, the Board concludes as a matter of law:

1. Respondent Monika Annette Wiltshire violated N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-85.38(a)(6).
2. Respondent admits that the conduct in this matter constitutes sufficient grounds for disciplinary action on her license under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-85.38.


Based upon the foregoing, and with the consent of the parties, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the license of Respondent Monika Annette Wiltshire is hereby SUSPENDED for a period of ONE (1) YEAR, which suspension shall be stayed until June 22, 2011, upon the following conditions:

1. Respondent shall maintain full compliance with both this Consent Order the New York Consent Order;
2. Respondent shall cooperate with the Board, the New York State Board of Pharmacy and either of those Boards' attorneys, investigators and other representatives in any investigation and compliance with the provisions of either this Consent Order or the New York Consent Order;
3. Respondent shall violate no laws governing the practice of pharmacy or the distribution of devices or medical equipment;
4. Respondent shall violate no rules and regulations of the Board; and
5. Respondent shall promptly advise the Board of any changes in address or employer, as well as any other factors affecting compliance with either this Consent Order or the New York Consent Order.

If Respondent fails to comply with any terms or conditions of this Order, Respondent may be subject to additional disciplinary action by the Board.
