David Burch was issued Technician Registration No. 01632, by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on January 8, 2002.

Technician Burch admits that while employed with Central Compounding Center South, Permit No. 09277, located on 6224 Fayetteville Rd, Durham, North Carolina and Central Compounding Center Permit No. 08260, located on 1921 Northpointe Dr, Durham, NC 27705, he has committed acts that give the North Carolina Board Pharmacy sufficient cause to revoke his pharmacist license. Considering that, Mr. Burch voluntarily surrenders his registration as a Pharmacy Technician in North Carolina.

Mr. Burch waives any further findings with respect to this matter. The surrender of the registration is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against him.

Mr. Burch understands and accepts that he is not to be present in a pharmacy setting unless he has a valid prescription from a treating physician. Mr. Burch also understands and accepts that he is not to work as a pharmacy technician in the state of North Carolina unless the registration is reinstated by the Board following a formal hearing.

Mr. Burch understands and accepts that, at any point in the future, he may petition for reinstatement by submitting a request to the Board of Pharmacy, in writing. Upon a request for reinstatement, the Board will determine within sixty (60) days when it will schedule a hearing on

the request for reinstatement. There is no presumption, guarantee or other implication intended within this document that the Board will reinstate the registration. The decision will be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at a formal hearing before the Board. The registration will not be returned until and unless the Board issues a reinstatement order after any formal hearing.


