Shelley was issued a Technician registration number 18367, by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on January 12, 2007.

Ms. Burgess admits that while employed as a pharmacy technician at Rite Aid Pharmacy, located at 1605 E. Innes St. Salisbury, North Carolina, she has committed acts that give the North Carolina Board Pharmacy sufficient cause to revoke her technician registration. Considering that, Ms. Burgess voluntarily surrenders her registration as a Pharmacy Technician in North Carolina.

Ms. Burgess waives any further findings with respect to this matter. The surrender of the registration is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against her.

Ms. Burgess understands and accepts that she is not to be present in a pharmacy setting unless she has a valid prescription from a treating physician and/or Ms. Burgess understands and accepts that she is not to work as a pharmacy technician in the state of North Carolina unless the registration is reinstated by the Board following a formal hearing. It is Ms. Burgess' responsibility to petition the Board for a hearing if she wishes to have the matter considered.


