
Steven Matthew Green was issued a Technician registration number 12778, by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on January 3, 2005, and renewed annually thereafter.

Mr. Green admits that while employed as a pharmacy technician at Tyro Family Pharmacy, Inc., located at 4320 S. N.C. Hwy 150, Lexington, North Carolina, he has committed acts that give the North Carolina Board Pharmacy ("Board") sufficient cause to revoke his technician registration. Considering that, Mr. Green voluntarily surrenders his registration as a Pharmacy Technician in North Carolina.

Mr. Green waives any further findings with respect to this matter. The surrender of the registration is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against him.

Mr. Green understands and accepts that he is not to be present in a pharmacy setting unless he has a valid prescription from a treating physician and/or Mr. Green understands and accepts that he is not to work as a pharmacy technician in the state of North Carolina unless the registration is reinstated by the Board following a formal hearing. It is Mr. Green's responsibility to petition the Board for a hearing if he wishes to have the matter considered. Further, there is no presumption; guarantee or other implication intended within this document that the Board will reinstate the registration. The decision would be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at the time of the formal hearing.
