Tamara G. Gunther was issued a Technician registration number 20430, by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on September 10, 2007.


Ms. Gunther admits that while employed as a pharmacy technician at Walgreens Pharmacy, located at 3251 Freedom Drive Charlotte, North Carolina, she has committed acts that give the North Carolina Board Pharmacy sufficient cause to revoke her technician registration. Considering that, Ms. Gunther voluntarily surrenders her registration as a Pharmacy Technician in North Carolina.

Ms. Gunther waives any further findings with respect to this matter. The surrender of the registration is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against her.

Ms. Gunther understands and accepts that she is not to be present in a pharmacy setting unless she has a valid prescription from a treating physician and/or Ms. Gunther understands and accepts that she is not to work as a pharmacy technician in the state of North Carolina unless the registration is reinstated by the Board following a formal hearing. It is Ms. Gunther's responsibility to petition the Board for a hearing if she wishes to have the matter considered.

Further, there is no presumption; guarantee or other implication intended within this document that the Board will reinstate the registration. The decision would be made by the Board based on consideration of all available evidence presented at the time of the formal hearing.
