Christopher Sanders was issued Technician registration number 22580, by the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy on April 1, 2008.

Mr. Christopher Sanders admits that while employed as a pharmacy technician at Rite Aid Pharmacy located at 4502 Shipyard Boulevard, Wilmington North Carolina, he has committed acts that give the North Carolina Board Pharmacy sufficient cause to revoke his technician registration. Considering that, Mr. Sanders voluntarily surrenders his registration as a Pharmacy Technician in North Carolina.


Mr. Sanders waives any further findings with respect to this matter. The surrender of the registration is made voluntarily and without pressure, coercion, or the threat of force being made against him.

Mr. Sanders understands and accepts that he is not to be present in a pharmacy setting unless he has a valid prescription from a treating physician. Mr. Sanders also understands and accepts that he is not to work as a pharmacy technician in the state of North Carolina unless the registration is reinstated by the Board following a formal hearing.

Mr. Sanders understands and accepts that, at any point in the future, he may petition for reinstatement by submitting a request to the Board of Pharmacy, in writing. Upon a request for reinstatement, the Board will determine within sixty (60) days when it will schedule a hearing on the request for reinstatement. There is no presumption, guarantee or other implication intended within this document that the Board will reinstate the registration.


