

The Board members met at 10:30 am by Conference call on Thursday, October 16, 2008 to consider the repeal of Rule .1507 Partial Examination

The meeting was called to order by Executive Director Jay Campbell with a quorum of Dr. Parker Chesson, Dr. Betty Dennis, Ms. Rebecca Chater, and Mr. Joey McLaughlin in attendance. Also participating in the call were, Board Counsel Clint Pinyan and Intern Emily Heil. Board members Stan Haywood and Wallace Nelson were not in attendance.

Jay Campbell Rule .1507 states “Candidates, who are found to be eligible for admission to the examinations in all respects except that of practical experience or age or both, may be admitted to all divisions of the examinations except the examination in practical pharmacy. Such a candidate may later take the practical examination when the experience requirement has been satisfied”. Mr. Campbell stated that this rule is no longer needed given the computer-based testing process.

A Public Hearing was held October 15, 2008 inconsideration of the rule repeal. There were no comments made during the hearing and no one in attendance.

On a motion from Rebecca Chater, seconded by Joey McLaughlin with no dissenting votes, the Board voted to repeal Rule .1507 Partial Examination.
